Guidelines:

Continuing Professional Development (CPD) for Dental Professionals in Malaysia

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1. INTRODUCTION

Continuing Professional Development (CPD) is the means by which members of profession or of professional associations maintain, improve and broaden their knowledge and skills, and develop the professional and personal qualities required in their professional lives. CPD requires a conscious commitment on the part of the professional to keeping up-todate and continuously seeking to improve.

All dental practitioners should therefore, participate in CPD activities, as CPD aims to assure that dental practitioners are updated and competent to provide high-quality oral healthcare that ensures patient protection.

To ensure subscription to CPD, accumulation of CPD points is now required for the renewal of Annual Practicing Certificates (APC) or Temporary Practicing Certificates (TPC) to practice dentistry in Malaysia. Hence, all dental practitioners who practice in Malaysia, whether citizens or non-citizens, are subject to this mandatory requirement, and this includes those who work on a contract basis.

2. **OBJECTIVE**

The objective of this document is to:

clarify the mechanism to claim CPD points for the purpose of APC or TPC renewal under the Dental Act, and

the requirements and processes involved in the conduct of knowledge and skills enhancement forums.

This document is thus, relevant for both dental practitioners and providers of CPD forums.

CPD ACTIVITIES 3.

Activities which are considered as CPD include:

- Congresses or Conferences
- Scientific Meetings
- Workshops, Courses or Attachments
- Continuing Dental/ Medical Education Sessions
- Presentations at Accredited Congresses/ Conferences/ Forums
- Publication of Articles in Journals or Reports
- Self Study
- Degree or Post-Graduate Programmes
- Involvement as Committee or Project Members in Quality Initiatives, Research Projects or Training Activities
- Editor or Member of Editorial Board or Referee or Reviewer
- Other Supporting Activities Related to Personal Development and Self Improvement
- Office Bearers of Societies/ Associations/ NGO and the equivalent.

It is recommended that the dental practitioner not only attend activities related to clinical updates but also give focus to areas health and safety (e.g. medical emergencies, infection control, radiography and radiation protection, legal and ethical issues and handling of complaints.

A wide variety of methods of CPD delivery can meet the necessary criteria, provided that such activities are approved by the national CPD committee appointed . However, CPD points need not necessarily be achieved only through attendance at approved courses.

The CPD credit point system that has been adopted by the Malaysian Dental Council is shown in **Appendix 1**.

4. REQUIREMENTS FOR CPD POINTS ACCUMULATION FOR RENEWAL OF PRACTISING CERTIFICATES

All dental practitioners shall ensure that the majority of CPD activities they undertake are relevant to the practice of dentistry. Under the Dental Act, all dental practitioners must produce evidence of CPD points for renewal of APC or TPC.

4.1 APC Renewal

CPD points are calculated based on the calendar year - 1 January to 31 December. Consideration of CPD points for APC renewal for the coming year shall be based on the CPD points of the previous year. For example, consideration of APC renewal for 2011 will be based on the CPD points in 2009. This will facilitate dental practitioners to apply for APC renewal any time from 1 February to 1 December 2010).

Newly-registered dental practitioners are exempted from providing evidence of CPD points for the first renewal of their APC. For example, a new registrant in May 2010, who applies for the first APC renewal at the latest by 1 December 2010, does not have to show proof of CPD points.

4.2 TPC Renewal

First time TPC applicants are also exempted from having to evidence of CPD points. Again, the same conditions as for APC renewal apply for the first TPC renewal.

4.3 Annual CPD Points Requirement

30 CPD actual points are required annually for renewal of the practicing certificate under the Dental Act. (Appendix 1 and 2)

4.4 Appeal Mechanism

If a dental practitioner fails to achieve the required 30 CPD actual points in any year, and his application for APC/TPC renewal is not approved, he may appeal in writing to the President of the Malaysian Dental Council (MDC) as follows:

5. EVIDENCE

Credit points accumulated in the previous years may be relevant in the consideration of the appeal.

It is the responsibility of every dental practitioner to keep his own CPD records and evidence of CPD activities for at least 5 years. A dental practitioner may also be required, for verification purposes, to show evidence of CPD participation at any time.

6. VERIFICATION

It requires an appointed authority ('supervisor')who will verify the accumulated CDD points Supervisors for dental practitioners in various agencies are as follows:

- In order to ensure a holistic approach to the CPD of dental practitioners, it is required that each dental practitioners gain CDP points from more than 1 category.
- Maximum points refer to the maximum that is accepted for each category per year (e.g Attending 3 conferences in one year will only result in a maximum of 20 CPD points being awarded)
- For all activities, certificate of attendance, certified attendance list, or other evidence for verification are required.
